We often take our oral health for granted, and many people don't even think about it until they are in pain. Somehow, it's become normal to think about our mouths and our teeth as completely separate from the rest of our body. But oral health is very closely related to overall health.

Preventive dental visits are an important way to maintain not just a healthy mouth but a healthy body as well. Regular dentist visits can detect signs of nutritional deficiencies, general infection, or even more serious systemic diseases. More than 120 diseases can cause specific signs and symptoms in and around the mouth and jaw, like swollen or bleeding gums, ulcers, dry mouth, bad breath, and metallic taste. But a dentist doing regular check-ups can spot symptoms that could indicate serious health problems elsewhere in the body.

Some of these health concerns include:

Heart disease

People with gum disease have nearly double the risk for heart disease as those with healthy gums, according to the American Academy of Periodontology.

Diabetes

Studies show that people with diabetes are more susceptible to the development of gum disease and other oral health problems.

Pregnancy

During pregnancy, hormonal changes may increase the risk of gingivitis (inflammation of the gums).

Oral cancer

Your dentist can screen for oral cancer and other cancers of the head and neck when you go in for a regular check-up. Survival rates greatly increase the earlier the cancer is discovered and treated.

Poor oral health has been linked to heart disease, diabetes, and kidney disease. More than

90%

of all systemic diseases are linked to oral health.¹ Poor oral health can lead to and escalate serious overall health issues.

Creating a Subscriber Account



When you log in to deltadentalco.com, it's easy to check your Delta Dental of Colorado benefits. 24 hours a day, seven days a week, you can go online to print member ID cards, find a provider, check the status of a claim, view your benefits, and more. Registration is simple; just follow the instructions below.

New user

- 1. Go to **deltadentalco.com** and select **Sign in/Register** on the white header bar then select **I am a Member**.
- 2. Select Create an account and a new browser window will open.
- 3. Select I am a member or adult dependent and have coverage with Delta Dental and select Proceed to Step 2.
- 4. Enter the required information in the fields provided and click **Register**.
- 5. Complete the required fields.
- 6. Select a security question and provide the answer, then select **Register**.

Forgot username or password?

- Go to deltadentalco.com and select Sign in/Register on the white header bar then select I am a Member.
- 2. At the bottom, select **username** or **password** depending on which one you've forgotten and a new browser window will open.
- 3. Select I am a member or adult dependent and have coverage with Delta Dental and select Proceed to Step 2.
- 4. Enter the required information in the fields provided and select **Proceed to Step 3**.
- 5. Answer the security question that was created when you registered and select **Proceed** to Step 4.
- 6. Enter your email address and select **Continue**.
- 7. Once your email is verified, select **Continue** and you will receive an email containing your username/password information.



Estimating your dental care costs is simple. Asking your dentist for a pre-determination estimate* from Delta Dental before you agree to receive any recommended major treatment, lets you know up front what the plan will pay, and the difference you will be responsible for.

A pre-determination estimate is useful for costlier procedures such as:

- Crowns
- Wisdom-tooth extractions
- Implants
- Bridges
- Dentures
- Periodontal surgery

When your dentist submits a pre-determination estimate to Delta Dental, Delta Dental sends them an estimate of your share of the cost and how much Delta Dental will pay.

Dental care cost estimator

Our dental care cost estimator provides estimated cost ranges for common dental care needs. Our cost estimates reflect the range of fees charged by dentists in your area, both in and out of our dental networks. Remember you will receive the greatest out-of-pocket savings if you see a Delta Dental PPO™ provider.

Using the dental care cost estimator*

- 1. Log in to your member account at **deltadentalco.com** or the Delta Dental mobile app.
- 2. Click on the Cost Estimator tab.
- 3. Enter the required information: Zip code, treatment category, and dentist last name.
- 4. To obtain cost information for a specific procedure, contact your dentist directly for a pre-determination estimate.

*The cost estimator or pre-determination estimate are not a guarantee of payment. When the services are complete and a claim is received for payment, Delta Dental will calculate its payment based on your current eligibility, amount remaining in your annual maximum, and any deductible requirements.
